**[PROPOSED] ORDER REGARDING
OPENINGS OF GRAND VIEW
MEMORIAL PARK FOR PUBLIC
VISITATION THROUGH JANUARY
24, 2010**

TO ALL PARTIES HEREIN, THEIR COUNSEL AND ALL OTHER
INTERESTED PARTIES:

The Court after hearing from all parties in the related actions and interested
parties and in balancing the reasonable concerns of litigation against the legitimate

1 desire of the survivors and the community to see Grand View Memorial Park (“Grand
2 View”) restored to some level of function and to provide for loved ones interred at
3 Grand View, hereby makes the following orders:

4 **ORDERS**

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

6 **1. OBEY ALL LAWS**

7 That the operator of Grand View shall comply with all Federal, State and local
8 laws including those governing the programs regulated by the Department of
9 Consumer Affairs and Funeral Bureau (“Bureau”).

10 **2. OBEY PRIOR ORDERS**

11 That the operator of Grand View shall comply with all the terms and
12 conditions of all orders issued by this Court regarding preservation of evidence and
13 all orders issued by the Administrative Law Judge in the administrative action against
14 Grand View, effective as of the date of the execution of this order except as is
15 modified herein. Specifically the operator is to take care to ensure compliance with
16 the Evidence Preservation Order executed by the Court and filed on October 4, 2006.


17 **3. ORDER ALLOWING PUBLIC VISITATION ON MULTIPLE**
18 **DATES**

19 On November 1, November 15, November 26 [Thanksgiving], December 13,
20 and December 25 [Christmas], 2009 and January 1 [New Years Day], January 6
21 [Armenian Christmas], January 10, and January 24, 2010, Grand View will be open
22 for public visitation from 12 noon-4 p.m. Visitors who are on the cemetery grounds
23 at these visitations may clean markers, hand trim dried grass, irrigate grass by hand
24 and leave commemorative items at the gravesites. The cemetery authority pursuant
25 to the Health & Safety Code may impose additional limitations on visitor actions as it
26 may determine necessary. At the last status conference in the *In Re Grand View*
27 *Memorial Park* cases to be held prior to January 24, 2010, the interested parties will
28 report to the Court and propose additional dates for public visitation.
